Steht das **reporting verb** in der **past tense**, dann **ändern sich in der Folge die Zeiten**.

reporting verb in past tense	→	ÄNDERUNG DER ZEITEN
present	→	past
past	→	past perfect
present perfect	→	past perfect
past perfect	→	past perfect (bleibt unverändert!)
future	→	conditional / would + Nennform

now	→	then
here	→	there
this	→	that
these	→	those
today	→	that day
yesterday	→	the day before
last week	→	the week before/the previous week
last month	→	the month before/the previous month
last year	→	the year before/the previous year
tomorrow	→	the next day
next week	→	the following week
next month	→	the following month
next year	→	the following year
ago	→	before

Wenn du eine Aussage einer anderen Person in die indirekte Rede setzt, passiert etwas ganz automatisch: Du passt die Pronomen deinem Standpunkt an.

	direkte Rede	indirekte Rede
Personalpronomen	<i>I, you</i> <i>we, you</i>	<i>he/she</i> <i>they</i>
Possessivpronomen	<i>my, your</i> <i>our, your</i>	<i>his/her</i> <i>their</i>
Objektpronomen	<i>me, you</i> <i>us, you</i>	<i>him/her</i> <i>them</i>
Demonstrativpronomen (-artikel)	<i>this</i> <i>these</i>	<i>that</i> <i>those</i>
